

Topics covered in these programs

Refresher Program:

This program reviews and assesses the skills and knowledge introduced in an Apply first aid HLTFA301B course.

Refresher program Pre-requisite:

An Apply first aid credential or recognised equivalent (not achieved in a 'refresher' format) achieved within the last 3 years.

A revision workbook is issued at the time your course booking is confirmed. It is strongly recommended that you complete this workbook and bring it with you on the day of the course

Due to the dynamic and ever changing nature of first aid, St John permits attendance at only one (1) Refresher program between two (2) full Apply first aid courses. The performance criteria assessed during this program directly correlates to the performance criteria of Apply first aid HLTFA301B

Flexible Learning 1 Day Practical Skill Workshop:

St John now offers the Nationally Accredited 'Apply first aid' credential through flexible learning options.

Obtain your First Aid credential by completing some study on your own, using a Learner Guide Workbook or a CD-ROM, at a time, place and pace that suits you. Then simply attend a one day workshop covering the practical aspects of the course and assessment.

Flexible Learning—Minimum entry standard:

Participants must be 14 yrs of age

How does Apply first aid (flexible learning option) work?

Flexible learning allows you to choose your preferred learning method and combines a number of different options to make learning easier for you. Choose either Learner Guide Workbook or CD-ROM.

Complete the exercises at a time, place and pace that suits you. It's recommended that you spread your learning over a couple of weeks.

Course booking terms and conditions

1. Course payment must be received at the time of booking or within a time negotiated with Training Administration staff (no more than 7 working days). Until payment is received your name will appear on the course WAIT LIST and will be moved into the class list once your payment is received.
(a) A Purchase/Work/Service Order Number is recognised as payment received
2. If the course you are booking into commences within seven (7) working days payment must be received within 24 hours of booking unless alternative arrangements are approved.
3. Payment for courses may be made in person at our Nhulunbuy Ambulance Centre or over the phone. Credit cards accepted are Bankcard, MasterCard, Visa, Diners and American Express.
4. **Transfer:** You may transfer your course enrolment to another course provided ❶; at least seven days notice is given to the Training Department with such notice to be in writing and, ❷; a vacancy exists for the date you wish to transfer to.
(a) A \$10.00 TRANSFER FEE WILL APPLY.
5. **Cancellation:** Where it is necessary for you to cancel your attendance and St John has received your payment or an invoice has been issued,
(a) an ADMINISTRATION CHARGE OF \$10.00 will be deducted from your refund.
(b) All such cancellations must be advised in writing.
(c) Persons wishing to cancel their attendance at a course must do so at least seven (7) working days prior to course commencement. Failure to do so may result in the forfeiture of course fees previously paid.
6. **Refunds:** To obtain a refund of course fees paid please provide St John with ❶; the original receipt issued at time of payment, or ❷; another form of proof of identity.
(a) Course payments WILL NOT be refunded where a person fails to attend a course and has not previously notified St John (see above).
(b) An exception to this condition will be where the person is able to show good cause for such non-attendance. Good cause includes – but is not limited to – presentation of a Medical Certificate; unanticipated changes to work commitments, (employer confirmation required) etc.
7. **Course payments will not be refunded after the commencement of a course.**
