- 1. The St John NT 2025 Excellence Awards (the Awards) are conducted by St John Ambulance Australia (NT) Inc. (St John NT).
- 2. The Awards nomination period is from Wednesday 20 August 2025 to midnight, Tuesday 30 September 2025.
- 3. The Awards include 16 categories, celebrating and recognising the paramedics, volunteers and staff of St John NT who demonstrate excellence in leadership or clinical practice, an outstanding level of care, professionalism and compassion for members of the Northern Territory community.

Who can nominate

- 6. Nominations by immediate family members of the nominee will not be accepted.

- 9. Nominations are open for all individual categories.
- 10. All divisions are automatically nominated for the Youth Division of the Year and Adult Division of the Year Awards.
- 11. All nomination forms remain the property of St John NT.

Selection criteria

- 12. All nominations will be judged against the following key selection criteria:
 - **Leadership** How the nominee demonstrates excellence in leadership of clinical practice or professional skills. This may be through an outstanding level of care, professionalism and/or compassion for members of the Northern Territory community.
 - Role model How the nominee acts as a role model to their peers and the organisation.
 - **St John NT values** How the nominee goes above and beyond the call of duty, clearly displaying St John NT's values: integrity, respect, collaboration and empathy.
- 13. In addition to the nomination form, St John NT reserves the right to consider engagement with the organisation, participation in initiatives and programs, and volunteers' hours of service.
- 14. In addition, the following desirable criteria will be considered:
 - A sound knowledge and understanding of their area of service or expertise
 - Well presented
 - Good interpersonal skills

15. Finalists will be determined by a panel of judges, comprised of staff, volunteers and sponsors of St John NT.

Essence of St John Award	Recognises staff and volunteers who live and breathe the St John spirit, demonstrating exceptional compassion, leadership and selflessness in all aspects of their work. Recipients exhibit behaviour in line with the St John NT mission to save lives and build community resilience and exemplify the core values: respect, integrity, collaboration and empathy. Quiet achievers, recipients often perform their tasks with minimal fuss, and work may go largely unnoticed but is critical to business operations.	Open to all St John NT staff and volunteers. Completed 6+ months as a staff member or volunteer for St John NT. Has not won this Award in the last three years.
Paramedic of the Year (inc. Northern and Southern)	Recognises qualified paramedics who demonstrate outstanding dedication and professionalism, making a significant impact on the field through exceptional patient care and support. Recipients go above and beyond in their practice, demonstrating leadership, mentoring colleagues, and promoting excellence within the paramedicine profession. Note: Paramedic of the Year awards for the Northern and Southern regions will be selected from submissions to the Paramedic of the Year Award category.
