# ELECTRICAL SERVICES FIRST AID

This course provides participants with the skills to manage common first aid situations that can arise in an electrical services industry environment, including rescue from low voltage panels. It is suitable for people employed as electricians and others employed in the electrical services industry.

## COURSE DURATION

One day of face-to-face training, practical activities and assessment.

## CERTIFICATE

On successful completion of this course you will be issued a statement of attainment in:

- UETDRRF10 Provide first aid in an ESI environment
- UETDRRF06 Perform rescue from a live LV panel
- HLTAID001 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation

St John recommends, as per the *First Aid in the Workplace Code of Practice* and the Australian Resuscitation Council guidelines, that electrical services first aid skills are renewed every 12 months.

- Defibrillation awareness
- Managing the unconscious, breathing casualty
- Introduction to low voltage principles
- Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)
- Rescue from low voltage apparatus
- Choking
- Hazards and risk management
- Legal issues
- Wounds and bleeding
- Infection control
- Bites and stings

## ASSESSMENT METHODS

A successful outcome for this statement of attainment will be determined by a range of different assessment methods including written assessment, observation of simulated and practical activities etc.

You will be required to demonstrate CPR on a manikin on the floor.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS/PREREQUISITES

There are no entry requirements or prerequisites to undertake this training.
