# PROVIDE FIRST AID

The flagship St John Ambulance first aid course covers a comprehensive range of topics to enable participants to confidently manage emergency situations and provide a first aid response to a casualty. It covers the most common first aid injuries and illnesses.

It is suitable for both people in the workplace and members of the public who want training in first aid.

(Previously known as Senior First Aid, Workplace Level 2, and Apply First Aid.)

## COURSE DURATION

St John offers the following options:

- 2 days. This is best suited to people who are new to first aid or where English is a second language.
- 1 day. Students complete an e-learning module and one day face-to-face of practice and assessment. This course is appropriate for experienced first aiders and people who complete their training regularly.
- Assessment only. This course is for those who are confident in their skills and only want to complete the assessment. Students complete an e-learning module and assessment (half day).

## CERTIFICATE

On successful completion of this course you will be issued a statement of attainment in:

- HLTAID001 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation
- HLTAID002 Provide basic emergency life support
- HLTAID003 Provide first aid

St John recommends, as per the *First Aid in the Workplace Code of Practice* and the Australian Resuscitation Council guidelines, that first aid skills are renewed every 3 years and resuscitation skills (HLTAID001/HLTAID007) are renewed every 12 months.

- Poisoning management
- Bites and stings
- Stroke



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### ASSESSMENT METHODS

A successful outcome for this statement of attainment will be determined by a range of different assessment methods including written assessment, observation of simulated and practical activities etc.

You will be required to demonstrate CPR on a manikin on the floor.

There are no entry requirements or prerequisites to undertake this training.
