

Advanced Resuscitation

Options available: 1 day OR assessment only (half day)



The St John Advanced Resuscitation course is a course designed for experienced first aiders who use specific equipment and often work in higher risk environments. This course develops advanced skills for providing life support and focuses on the use of oxygen delivery systems and in-depth knowledge and skill in the use of Automated External Defibrillators (AED).

Certificate:

On successful completion of this course you will be issued a Certificate which is a statement of attainment in:

- HLTAID001 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation
- HLTAID007 Provide advanced resuscitation

St John recommends, in line with Australian Resuscitation Council guidelines and Safework Australia's First Aid in the Workplace Code of Practice, recommend that resuscitation skills are renewed (HLTAID001 and HLTAID007) every 12 months.

Course Outline:

This course covers the following:

- DRSABCD action plan
- Infection control
- Automated External Defibrillation (AED)
- Soft bag resuscitation
- Administration of oxygen
- Oxygen delivery systems
- Oxygen powered resuscitation
- Oropharyngeal airways
- Suction equipment

Assessment is through a combination of practical first aid activities and a written test paper. You will be required to demonstrate CPR on a manikin on the floor.

Entry Requirements/Prerequisites

There are no entry requirements or prerequisites to undertake this training.

Course duration

St John offers two different options for this course.

- **One day** face-to-face training and assessment.
- **Assessment only.** Half day face-to-face of short practice and then assessment. This course is for those who are confident in their skills and want to gain their certification quickly. It is appropriate for experienced first aiders, health care professionals and people who complete their training regularly.
