

Asthma and Anaphylaxis in the Workplace

This course is designed to give you the confidence, knowledge and skills to recognise and manage an asthmatic and anaphylactic reaction including the use of the asthma inhaler and the adrenaline auto-injector.

St John recommends, in line with Australian Resuscitation Council guidelines and Safework Australia's First Aid in the Workplace Code of Practice, recommend that first aid skills are renewed at least three years and CPR skills are renewed (HLTAID001) every 12 months.

Course Outline:

This course covers the following:

- Asthma, Anaphylaxis and allergy overview
- Asthma and Anaphylaxis signs, symptoms and triggers
- Asthma and Anaphylaxis medications and devices
- Asthma and Anaphylaxis action plans
- Asthma and Anaphylaxis risk management planning for the workplace
- Hands-on-practice in using Asthma inhalers and spacers
- Hands-on-practice adrenaline auto-injector administration (Epi-pen and Anapen)
- Asthma and Anaphylaxis first aid management

Assessment is through a combination of practical first aid activities and a written test paper. You will be required to demonstrate CPR on a manikin on the floor.

Entry Requirements/Prerequisites

There are no entry requirements or prerequisites to undertake this training however it is recommended that students have current CPR training as well.
