Options available: Half day OR assessment only (1.5 hours with pre-work)

The St John Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) course gives you the skills to perform CPR on a person who is unconscious and not breathing normally. You will have the knowledge and confidence to perform CPR on an adult, child and infant, to describe alternative methods for delivering rescue breaths and how to manage a victim of drowning.

Certificate:

On successful completion of this course you will be issued a Certificate which is a statement of attainment

in:

- HLTAID001 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation

St John recommends, in line with Australian Resuscitation Council guidelines and Safework Australia's First Aid in the Workplace Code of Practice, that CPR skills are renewed (HLTAID001) every 12 months.

Course Outline:

This course covers the following:

- The DRSABCD action plan and responding to emergency situations
- Managing unconscious casualties
- Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)
- Using a defibrillator (AED)
- Legal issues in first aid
- Infection control

Assessment is through a combination of practical first aid activities and a written test paper. You will be required to demonstrate CPR on a manikin on the floor.

Entry Requirements/Prerequisites

There are no entry requirements or prerequisites to undertake this training.

Course duration

St John offers the following:

- **Half day.** This is best suited to people who are new to CPR or would like to gain in-depth strong life-saving skills.
- **Assessment only.** Students complete an e-learning module and 1.5 hours face-to-face of short practice and then assessment. This course is for those who are confident in their skills and want to gain their certification quickly. It is appropriate for experienced first aiders, health care professionals and people who complete their training regularly.
