- Burns
- Eye injuries
- Use of ice
- Sprains
- Fractures
- Bites and Stings
- Heat Illness

There is no formal assessment as part of this course, but opportunity is provided to practice practical skills.

Entry Requirements/Prerequisites

There are no entry requirements or prerequisites to undertake this training.

One day, including class participation, practical activities, fun and games.
