

Low Voltage Rescue

Options available: half day OR assessment only (2 hours)

This course provides participants with the skills to manage the danger of accidental electrocution. It is primarily designed for electricians. After successful completion of this course you will be competent to rescue and provide resuscitation to a person who has stopped breathing or is unconscious due to low voltage electrical shock.



Certificate:

On successful completion of this course you will be issued a Certificate which is a statement of attainment in:

- UETDTRRF06B Perform rescue from a live LV panel
- HLTAID001 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation

St John recommends, in line with Australian Resuscitation Council guidelines and Safework Australia's First Aid in the Workplace Code of Practice, recommend that first aid skills are renewed at least three years and CPR skills are renewed (HLTAID001) every 12 months.

Course Outline:

This course covers the following:

- DRSABCD action plan
- Managing the unconscious, breathing casualty
- Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)
- Choking
- Legal issues
- Infection control
- Defibrillation awareness
- Introduction to low voltage principles
- Rescue from low voltage apparatus
- Hazards and risk management

Assessment is through a combination of practical first aid activities and a written test paper. You will be required to demonstrate CPR on a manikin on the floor

Entry Requirements/Prerequisites

There are no entry requirements or prerequisites to undertake this training.

Course duration

St John offers the following:

- **Half day** of face-to-face training, which is best suited to people who are new to low voltage rescue or would like to gain in-depth strong life-saving skills.
- **Assessment only.** 2 hours face-to-face of short practice and then assessment. This course is for those who are confident in their skills and want to regain their certification. It is appropriate for those who complete their training regularly.
