

Education and Care First Aid

Options available: 2 days, 1 day (with pre-work)



Education and Care First Aid is a course specifically designed to meet the needs of people working in the childcare and early childhood learning industry. This course is tailored towards anyone working with children. It covers child specific first aid in many high-risk areas such as anaphylaxis and asthma as well as common injuries and resuscitation. The Australian Children's Education & Care Authority (ACECQA) has endorsed this course as meeting their requirements for anaphylaxis, asthma, and first aid training.

Certificate:

On successful completion of this course you will be issued a Certificate which is a statement of attainment in:

- HLTAID001 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation
- HLTAID002 Provide basic emergency life support
- HLTAID003 Provide first aid
- HLTAID004 Provide an emergency first aid response in an education and care setting
- 22099VIC Course in First Aid Management of Anaphylaxis
- 22282VIC Course in the Emergency Management of Asthma in the Workplace

St John recommends, in line with Australian Resuscitation Council guidelines and Safework Australia's First Aid in the Workplace Code of Practice, recommend that this training is current for 3 years although CPR skills are renewed (HLTAID001) every 12 months.

Course Outline:

This course covers the following:

- DRSABCD action plan
- Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)
- Anaphylaxis
- Wounds and Bleeding
- Medical emergencies
- Heat and cold induced illness
- Strains, sprains, dislocations and fractures
- Chest and abdominal injuries
- Poisons
- Legal issues
- Defibrillation
- Managing the unconscious, breathing casualty
- Asthma
- Choking
- Burns
- Shock
- Safety and risk management
- Head, neck and spinal injuries
- Facial and eye injuries
- Bites and Stings
- Infection control

Assessment is through a combination of practical first aid activities and a written test paper. You will be required to demonstrate CPR on a manikin on the floor.

Entry Requirements/Prerequisites

There are no entry requirements or prerequisites to undertake this training.

Course duration

St John offers the following:

- **2 days** – This is best suited to people who are new to first aid or where English is a second language.
 - **1 day** – Students complete an e-learning module and one day face-to-face of practice and assessment. This course is for those who are confident in their skills and want to gain their certification quickly. It is appropriate for experienced first aiders and people who complete their training regularly.
