Terms and Conditions

1. The St John NT Excellence Awards 2022 (the Awards) are conducted by St John Ambulance Australia (NT) Inc. (St John NT).
2. The Awards will be open for nominations from 1 September 2022 until 7 October 2022.
3. The Awards include 13 categories and celebrate and recognise the paramedics, staff and volunteers of St John NT who demonstrate excellence in leadership or clinical practice, an outstanding level of care, professionalism and compassion for members of the Northern Territory community.
4. **The Award categories:**
 - Junior Volunteer of the Year
 - Youth Volunteer of the Year
 - Adult Volunteer of the Year
 - Peter Falkland Youth Leader
 - Operational Support Member of the Year (volunteer)
 - Youth Division of the Year
 - Adult Division of the Year
 - Paramedic of the Year – Southern
 - Paramedic of the Year – Northern
 - Patient Transport Officer of the Year
 - Emergency Medical Dispatcher of the Year
 - Excellence in Service
 - Paramedic of the Year

Who can nominate?

5. Nominations may be submitted by members of the public, organisations working with St John NT, St John NT staff and volunteers.
6. Nominations will not be accepted from immediate family members.

How to nominate someone for an Award

7. All nominations must be completed online at <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/stntexcellence2022> by midnight 7 October 2022.
8. If you are unable to submit the online form, please contact St John NT Marketing & Communications on 8922 6270 or marketing@stjohnnt.asn.au and an alternative nomination form will be made available.
9. Nominations are open in all categories listed on the Nomination Form. The Paramedic of the Year will be selected from the Northern and Southern Paramedic of the year. Recipients of the Volunteer categories of the Adult Division of the Year, the Youth Division of the Year and the Peter Falkland Youth Leader will be selected by an internal panel at St John NT.
10. Excellence in Service Award is open to all St John NT staff in corporate services, retail, first aid training and vehicle services.
11. In addition to the Nomination Form, St John NT reserves the right to take into consideration engagement with the organisation, participation in initiatives and programs and volunteers' hours of services.
12. Judging of the Award categories will be conducted by a panel of judges representing staff and volunteers of St John NT.
13. All Nomination Forms remain the property of St John NT.

Selection Criteria

14. Entry is open to all current staff and volunteers of St John NT.
15. All nominations will be judged against the following key selection criteria:

- **Leadership** - How the nominee demonstrates excellence in leadership of clinical practice or professional skills - this may be demonstrated through an outstanding level of care, professionalism and compassion for members of the Northern Territory Community
 - **Role model:** How the nominee acts as a role model to their peers and the organisation.
 - **St John NT values** – How the nominee goes above and beyond the call of duty, clearly displaying St John NT’s values of integrity, respect, empathy and collaboration.
16. In addition, it is expected that the nominee will demonstrate the following desirable criteria:
- A sound knowledge and understanding of their area of service
 - Well presented
 - Good inter-personal skills
17. The judges will select **one winner and one runner up only** per category, both of which will be invited to the Awards ceremony as finalists.

18. Essential criteria per category

Adult Volunteer of the Year	Is aged 18 years and over Has undertaken over 60 hours of community service Has completed at least one year of efficient service Regularly attends Divisional Training nights Encourages and regularly uses DMS Has not won this Award in the last three years
Youth Volunteer Member of the Year	Is aged between 12 - 17 years Has completed four proficiency badges Has undertaken a minimum of 100 hours service (duty, other volunteer, meeting hours) Has been active in attending public events Has completed a minimum of 12 months services Has not won this Award before
Junior Volunteer Member of the Year	Is aged between 8 – 11 years Has at least four Interest certificates at the time of nomination Has been an active junior by attending public events
Operational Support Volunteer member of the Year	Has undertaken over 60 hours of community service Has completed a minimum of 12 months services Has not won this Award in the last three years
Peter Falkland Youth Leader Award	Is aged between 17 – 26 years old (Youth) Has undertaken minimum of 150 hours of community Service Have completed 3 years of efficient service Has obtained at least 6 proficiency badges Has not won this award before
Paramedic/ Emergency Medical Dispatcher/Patient Transport Officer of the Year Awards	Has worked in the region/role they are being nominated in for greater than three months. Has not won this Award in the last three years
Excellence in Service Award	Has worked in the role for more than three months. Has not won this Award in the last three years.
