- Scene control
- Triage
- Identifying injuries
- Bleeding management
- Advance bleeding control
- Management of shock
- CPR and airway management
- Helmet removal
- Spinal injury protocol
- Fractures, dislocations, sprains and strains
- Burns and grazes

This course does not have a formal assessment but exercises to learn and demonstrate the practical skills are included.
